

Graduate Feeder Program – Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the Fall 2026 deadline for the Graduate Feeder Program?

The application deadline for Fall 2026 was May 1, 2026. The deadline has passed, and the Fall 2026 application cycle is now closed.

2. If I missed the deadline for Fall 2026, can I still apply?

Yes, you may still submit an application; however, all applications received will be reviewed and considered for Spring 2027, as the program has already met its capacity for the Fall 2026 term.

What is the application deadline for Spring 2027?

The application deadline for the Spring 2027 Graduate Feeder Scholars Program is December 1, 2026. Applications must be submitted by this date to be considered for the Spring 2027 cohort.

When will Spring 2027 applications be reviewed, and when will decisions be sent?

Spring 2027 applications will be reviewed after the December 1, 2026 application deadline. Admission decisions will be sent in late December 2026, prior to the start of the Spring 2027 semester in January.

3. Where can I access the application?

The application is available on the Graduate Feeder Program website.

4. Am I eligible if I have already graduated?

Yes. Recent graduates within one year of graduation are eligible to apply.

5. Can I apply for the Graduate Feeder Scholars Program if I am graduating in the same semester?

Yes. You may apply if you are graduating during the same semester, as the induction ceremony takes place prior to graduation.

6. Do I need to take any additional steps after applying?

No. If accepted, you will receive an invitation to join the program's Canvas course site. Please monitor your email and Canvas for updates.

7. How do I access the workshops?

Workshop access will be granted through Canvas once you are officially admitted into the program.

1. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
2. Submit a typed and fully completed Graduate Feeder Participation Application.
3. Be a current FAMU student or a FAMU graduate within the past year.
